Smile Relief Program

Emergency food relief, medical supplies, and basic necessities for families affected by crisis. Reached 500+ families since 2020.

Tabasamu Education Support Scheme [TESS]

School fees, scholastic materials, and mentorship for orphans and vulnerable children in primary and secondary schools.

Clean Water & Health Access Project

Partnering with local clinics to promote hygiene, provide medical outreaches, and support access to clean water in vulnerable communities.

Goal: Economic independence for youth and women.
Training in modern farming, animal husbandry, poultry, and fisheries. Includes a demonstration farm and market linkage support.
Target: 1,000 beneficiaries in 3 years

She Rises Women Empowerment Program

Goal: Financial independence for disadvantaged women.
Vocational skills, micro-grants, SACCO formation, and business mentorship. Focus on tailoring, crafts, catering, and ICT.
Target: 500 women annually

Future Leaders Academy

Goal: Leadership and skills for Uganda's youth.
Bootcamps in digital literacy, entrepreneurship, public speaking, and civic responsibility. Annual "Tabasamu Youth Summit".
Target: 2,000 youth in 3 years

Tabasamu Health & Wellness Caravan

Goal: Take healthcare to the people.
Mobile clinics, health education, maternal health, and mental health counseling in rural areas.
Partners: Local health centers, medical volunteers

Green Tabasamu Initiative

Goal: Climate action and sanitation.
School and community tree planting, waste recycling, and promotion of clean cooking energy.
Target: Plant 50,000 trees by 2031

Tabasamu Orphan & Vulnerable Children Home

Goal: A safe, self-sustaining home with education, psycho-social support, and skills training.
Includes land acquisition and income-generating projects to ensure long-term sustainability.

Mindset & Civic Transformation Campaign

Goal: Promote patriotism, integrity, hard work, and responsible citizenship through radio, schools, and community dialogues.
